100 Mile House 2006 Northern B.C. Winter Games

Bowling

- Categories:** **Youth Division:** Combined Junior (11-13) and Senior (14-18)
Seniors Division: 55 and over
Special Olympics: Co-ed (12 and over)
- Participants** **Youth Division:** 2 males (one from each age category) and 2 females (one from each age category) plus 1 Coach / Manager (5 max.) per region. A maximum of 32 athlete and 16 coaches/ managers will be permitted for the sport in the Youth Division.
- Seniors Division:** 2 males and 2 females plus 1 coach/manager (max. 5) per region. A maximum of 32 athletes and 8 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport in the Seniors Division.
- Special Olympics:** 5 players plus 1 Coach (max 5) per region. A maximum of 40 athletes and 8 coaches will be permitted for the sport in the Special Olympics Division. Note that chaperones will be permitted to be added, as required.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern B.C. Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** Canadian and BC Five Pin Bowling Association rules and regulations.
- Eligibility:** Age as of Dec. 31st year prior to the Games.
Eligibility is based on most pins over average.
Bowlers will not coach or be part of a team event.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 Theory recommended.
- Sanctioning:** None
- Entry Fee:** \$60.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).
- Tournament Draw:** Single round robin. 8 game – pins over average
- Officials:** A maximum of 8 officials are permitted for the sport
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals in each category. When there are four or more competitors or teams, Bronze, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are three competitors or teams, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are two competitors or teams only a Gold medal will be awarded. Only Northern B.C. Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
