## 100 Mile House 2006 Northern B.C. Winter Games

### Karate

- Categories:** Male & Female events in the following:

- \* Weight divisions for all categories will be determined based on entries*
- Participants:** 20 athletes plus 2 coaches/managers (max 22) per region. A maximum of 160 athletes and 16 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern B.C. Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** as per Karate BC policy.
- Eligibility:** Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games. Athletes must be members of Karate BC 30 days prior to the Games in order to participate.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 Certification required
- Officials:** A maximum of 12 officials will be permitted for the sport.  
An Officials Clinic will be held in conjunction with the competition
- Sanctioning:** Karate BC
- Entry Fee:** \$60.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).
- Tournament Draw:** Kata: elimination/performance. Repechage system.  
Kumite: Repechage system. Round Robin with three or fewer competitors.
- Notes:** All participants must show Karate BC membership at time of participation in the Regional Playdowns. Karate BC or N.K.A. waiver form must be completed by all participants.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and two (2) Bronze medals will be awarded in each weight division for each age category for both males and females. When there are four or more competitors or teams, two Bronze, one Silver and one Gold medal will be awarded. When there are three competitors or teams, only Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are two competitors or teams only a Gold medal will be awarded. Only Northern B.C. Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
- Venue Requirements:** High School or Middle School gymnasium, large enough to hold two competition areas of 10x10 each with safety space between.
- Venue:** Horse Lake Elementary School
