



Sport Technical Package

100 Mile House 2006 Northern B.C. Winter Games

Skiing - Alpine

Male and Female events in each of the following:

K1 category: 11-12 years

K2 category: 13-14 years

J1 category: 15-16 years

J2 category: 17-18 years (athletes cannot have turned 19 by the first day of the Games)

Participants: 8 athletes plus 2 Coaches /Managers (10 max.) per region. A maximum of 64 athletes and 16 coaches / managers will be permitted for the sport.

Regional teams must be mixed with a minimum of 2 males or 2 females per region team.

Backfilling: Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern B.C. Winter Games Society will work with the PSO to backfill the unused spots from the list of substitute athletes, based on policy and ability to host.

Rules: Canadian Ski Association Regulations. BC Alpine rules apply.

Eligibility: Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games but athletes cannot have turned 19 by the first day of the Games.
Competitors must be members of BC Alpine

Coach Certification: NCCP/CSCF Entry Level (Level 1) Certified or Trained* (Note - Trained coaches must be using the Games as a mentoring opportunity).

Sanctioning: BC Alpine

Entry Fee: \$60.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).

Awards: Gold, Silver and Bronze medals in each age category for male and female events. When there are four or more competitors or teams, Bronze, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are three competitors or teams, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are two competitors or teams only a Gold medal will be awarded. Only Northern B.C. Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.

Officials: A maximum of 10 officials are permitted for the sport

Equipment: BC Alpine can assist in locating equipment.

Venue Requirements: Minimum vertical 200m; minimum width 30m. Machine grooming required. Lift service required.
