Participants: 28 athletes plus 2 Coaches/Managers (30max) per region. A maximum of 224 athletes and 16 coaches/managers are permitted for the sport.

Backfilling: Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern B.C. Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.

Coaching Level: NCCP Level I Certified, exemptions considered by BC Wrestling Association

Rules: CAWA/ BCWA/ BC High School Regulations

Eligibility: Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games.
Must be a member of Wrestling BC. Forms available at venue prior to event.

Sanctioning: BC Wrestling Association

Entry Fee: \$60.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).

Tournament Draw: Double Elimination. Round Robin where numbers dictate.

Notes: Weigh-in on arrival in the Host Community.

Officials: A maximum of 6 officials are permitted for the sport

Awards: Gold, Silver and Bronze medals in weight division. When there are four or more competitors or teams, Bronze, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are three competitors or teams, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are two competitors or teams only a Gold medal will be awarded. Only Northern B.C. Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.

Venue Requirements: A venue with a flat one-room surface that can accommodate 2 mats (40x40 or 30x30 each).
