Dawson Creek 2008 Northern BC Winter Games

February 7-10, 2008

Hockey

- Categories:** Boys Peewee House League (11-12 years old)
- Participants:** One team of 19 players plus 3 team officials (Coaches/Managers/Trainers) (max. 22) per region. A maximum of 152 athletes and 24 team officials will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of teams indicated above. The members of other teams must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused team berths from the list of substitute teams, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** BC Hockey. **No body-checking rule applies.**
- Eligibility:** Age as of December 31 prior to the Games. Players currently registered on Canada playing cards are not eligible for this event. House League Players only. For communities with 100 or more registered Pee Wee players, the players for this event **must** be from **one seasonally** registered team. Communities with fewer than 100 Peewee players may send a selected team of uncarded players. **The intent is to provide fair and equitable competition for all communities.** Membership in BC Hockey required. Refer to Policy and Procedures Manual for the Northern BC Winter Games for more details.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 Certified (BC Hockey) and Speak Out clinic attendance required
- Sanctioning:** BC Hockey
- Entry Fee:** \$65.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included). Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
- Tournament Draw:** Two (2) Pool Round Robin. Refer to Policy and Procedures Manual for the Northern BC Winter Games for more details.
- Officials:** A maximum of 8 officials are permitted for the sport. Officials must be named and registration submitted to BC Games Society staff by December 1, 2007.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
- Venue Requirements:** Ice Surface – ideal size: 200' x 100'
- Venue:** Kin Arena

Format for Playdowns:

2 teams - best 2 games of 3

3 teams - round robin tournament with a championship game

4 or more teams- round robin total points only (no championship game)

- Roster for playdowns must be submitted to BC Hockey District Director one week prior to the commencement of the playdowns
- No carded players allowed to play in the Northern BC Winter Games
- BC Hockey District Directors will oversee playdowns for Northern BC Winter Games

Refer to Policy and Procedures Manual for the Northern BC Winter Games for more details.

Registration:

Teams wishing to playdown for the Northern BC Winter Games must contact their BC Hockey District Director by November 1 of the current year. Team roster must be submitted to BC Hockey District Director one week prior to the playdowns commencing. Playdowns for the Northern BC Winter Games must be completed by December 1 of the current year. Registration information will be made available to the District playdown winner. Refer to Policy and Procedures Manual for the Northern BC Winter Games for more details.

Registration:

Online registration information is available from the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative.

Deadline for the completion of online registration is January 7, 2008 unless an earlier deadline is set by the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative.

Registration is completed online by the designated contact for each sport in each region. Registration fees are to be submitted to your Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative by the deadline. A completed Team List (for team events) must also be submitted to the Regional Representative by the deadline.

Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
