Snowboarding

- Categories:** Boys and Girls 12 - 14
Boys and Girls 15 - 18
- Participants:** 6 athletes plus 2 coaches/managers (max 10) per region. A maximum of 36 athletes and 16 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** BC Snowboard Association
- Eligibility:** Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games.
Participants must be registered members of BC Snowboard Association.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 Theory required
- Sanctioning:** BC Snowboard Association
- Entry Fee:** \$65.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included). Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
- Events:** Slopestyle and Snowboard Cross
- Tournament Draw:** Snowboard Park and Snowboard Cross
- Notes:** No raceboards for snowboard cross. Two (2) days of competition.
Participants will be required to pay hill fees. Helmets required.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
