



# Sport Technical Package

## Fort St. John 2007 Northern BC Winter Games

### Cyclocross

- Categories:** Junior (Under 19)  
Senior (Over 19)
- Participants:** 8 athletes plus 1 Coach/Manager per region. A maximum of 64 athletes and 8 Coaches/Managers will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other teams must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitute teams, based on policy and ability to host.
- Eligibility:** Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games.  
If the participant must be members of Cycling BC or obtain an event membership from Cycling BC, prior to the Games.
- Rules:** Cycling BC
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 Theory and/or Technical in cycling recommended.
- Entry Fee:** \$65.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).
- Officials:** A maximum of 5 officials are permitted for the sport.
- Race:** 2.8 km loop. A winding route that includes footpaths and small steeple chase-type obstacles.  
  
Timed events: 30 minutes for Juniors, 60 minutes for Seniors.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
- Venue:** Northern Peace Secondary School Grounds
