Participants: 28 athletes plus 2 Coaches/Managers (30max) per region. A maximum of 224 athletes and 16 coaches/managers are permitted for the sport.

Backfilling: Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.

Coaching Level: NCCP Level I Certified, exemptions considered by BC Wrestling Association

Rules: CAWA/ BCWA/ BC High School Regulations

Eligibility: Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games.
Must be a member of Wrestling BC. Forms available at venue prior to event.

Sanctioning: BC Wrestling Association

Entry Fee: \$65.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).

Tournament Draw: Double Elimination. Round Robin where numbers dictate.

Notes: Weigh-in on arrival in the Host Community.

Officials: A maximum of 8 officials are permitted for the sport

Awards: Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
