## Mackenzie 2009 Northern BC Winter Games

### February 12 - 15, 2009

## Figure Skating

- Categories:** **Singles - combined** 9 to 20 years of age in the following categories:
- Pre-Preliminary Northern Biathlon
  - Preliminary Northern Biathlon
  - Junior Bronze or equivalent Northern Biathlon
  - Senior Bronze or equivalent Northern Biathlon
  - Junior Silver or equivalent Northern Biathlon
  - Senior Silver or equivalent Northern Biathlon
  - Gold or equivalent Northern Biathlon
- Boys and girls will compete together.  
There will be an Interpretive Skate and a Freeskite for each category.
- Participants:** 14 skaters and 2 coaches/chaperones per region. A maximum of 112 athletes and 16 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Coach Certification:** Coaches must have NCCP Level 1
- Officials:** Officials will be appointed by Skate Canada (BC/YT Section) prior to the Games. A panel of up to 5 judges will be used for the competition. Two accountants must be used. A maximum of 8 officials are permitted for the sport. Officials must be named and registration submitted to BC Games Society staff by December 1, 2008.
- Rules:** Skate Canada rules will prevail.
- Eligibility:** Age as of July 1 prior to the Games.  
Participants must be registered members of Skate Canada (BC/YT Section).
- Sanctioning:** A Skate Canada Sanction must be in place. This will be requested by, and prepared by, Skate Canada (BC/YT Section) Northern contacts.
- Registration Fee:** \$70.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included). Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
- Tournament Draw:** Competition format. Draw conducted by the Chief Accountant and Chief Referee.

**Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in the Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category, no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
