Participants: 12 athletes in any combination of categories plus 2 Coaches/Managers (max 14) per region. A maximum of 96 athletes and 16 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport.

Backfilling: Each region may only register the number of participants indicated above. Other participants must be registered as substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.

Rules: BC Archery Association rules apply.

Eligibility: Age at December 31st prior to the Games.
Athletes must be members of the BC Archery Association.

Coach Certification: NCCP Level 1 certification is required.

Sanctioning: BC Archery Association

Entry Fee: \$75.00 per Athlete; \$25.00 per Coach/Manager. Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.

Tournament Draw: 4 Rounds FITA I (30 arrows at 18 metres)
2 Rounds Friday and 2 Rounds Saturday (Subject to participation)
Total Points (300 x 4 Rounds)

Notes: Juniors may shoot in Senior Categories. Each team (region) should have a designated Coach or Manager. Whites are requested, not mandatory.

Officials: A maximum of 4 officials are permitted for the sport. Officials must be named and registration submitted to BC Games Society staff by the Games registration deadline.

Awards: Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category, no medals will be awarded. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.

Venue Requirements: Absolute minimum is 70' x 70'. The light source must be artificial overhead lighting.
