Prince Rupert 2010 Northern BC Winter Games

February 4 - 7, 2010

Basketball

- Categories:** Junior Girls: Grade 10
Junior Boys: Grade 10
- Participants:** 12 athletes plus 2 coaches/managers (max. 14) per team. Two teams (one female and one male) per region. A maximum of 192 athletes and 32 coaches/managers are permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of participants indicated above. Other participants must be registered as substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** Modified FIBA High School rules.
- Eligibility:** Age as of December 31st prior to the Games.
Basketball BC membership required by the Games for injury insurance coverage.
- Coach Certification:** Coaches must be working to attain NCCP Level 1 certification.
- Sanctioning:** Basketball BC
- Entry Fee:** \$75.00 per Athlete; \$25.00 per Coach/Manager. Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
- Tournament Draw:** Pooled Round Robin. Single-game championship.
- Officials:** A maximum of 15 officials are permitted for the sport.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in the Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category, no medals will be awarded. This athlete/team may compete in an alternate category/event if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
- Venue Requirements:** A minimum of two gymnasiums measuring 84' x 45' each.
- Venue:** Charles Hays Secondary School

Registration:

Deadline for the completion of online registration is January 6, 2010 unless an earlier deadline is set by the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative.

- Registration is completed online by the designated contact for each sport in each region.
- Registration fees are to be submitted to the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative by the deadline.
- Completed Event and Team Lists (if applicable) must also be submitted to the Regional Representative by the deadline.
- Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
