Prince Rupert 2010 Northern BC Winter Games

February 4 - 7, 2010

Practical Shooting

- Divisions:** Revolver, Standard, Open and Production
- Classifications:** Grand Master, Master, A, B, C, D and Unclassified
- Participants:** 6 athletes per region. A maximum of 48 athletes are permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of participants indicated above. Other participants must be registered as substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** International Practical Shooting Confederation Competition Rules
- Eligibility:** No age restriction. Black badge course required (must be completed prior to the Games registration deadline). Current IPSC membership preferred.
- Sanctioning:** Level 1
- Entry Fee:** \$75.00 per Athlete; \$25.00 per Coach/Manager. Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
- Tournament Draw:** Classes will be determined upon confirmation of the participant registration numbers.
- Notes:** All competitors and officials MUST wear hearing and eye protection while on the range.
- Officials:** Officials must be named and registration submitted to BC Games Society staff by the Games registration deadline.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category, no medals will be awarded. This athlete/team may compete in an alternate category/event if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
- Venue:** Prince Rupert Rod and Gun Club

Deadline for the completion of online registration is January 6, 2010 unless an earlier deadline is set by the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative.

- Registration is completed online by the designated contact for each sport in each region.
- Registration fees are to be submitted to the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative by the deadline.
- Completed Event and Team Lists (if applicable) must also be submitted to the Regional Representative by the deadline.
- Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
