Prince Rupert 2010 Northern BC Winter Games

February 4 - 7, 2010

Volleyball

- Categories:** 16U Girls (born in 1994 or later)
16U Boys (born in 1994 or later)
- Participants:** 12 athletes plus 2 coaches and 1 manager (max. 15) per team. Two teams (one female and one male) per region. A maximum of 192 athletes and 48 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of participants indicated above. Other participants must be registered as substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** Volleyball Canada 2009 - 2010 Regulations
- Eligibility:** Volleyball BC membership is required for athletes, coaches, managers, and officials. Registration information available from Volleyball BC (www.volleyballbc.ca or 604-291-2007). National level players are ineligible for this event.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 Certified
- Sanctioning:** Volleyball BC
- Entry Fee:** \$75.00 per Athlete; \$25.00 per Coach/Manager. Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
- Tournament Draw:** Round Robin - championship and consolation pools. Best two of three matches. First two to 25, win by 2, third and deciding match is played to 15, win by 2. No cap in any game. Draw will be developed by the Sport Chair and approved by Volleyball BC.
- Notes:** All matches use rally point scoring. Volleyball Canada tie-breaking procedures will be used.
- Officials:** A maximum of 6 officials are permitted for the sport. Officials must be named and registration submitted to BC Games Society staff by the Games registration deadline.
- Equipment:** 15-0 Baden Volleyballs are recommended for competition.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category, no medals will be awarded. This athlete/team may compete in an alternate category/event if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.

Venue Requirements: High School or Middle School Gymnasium, 2 courts (18m x 9m)

Venue: Prince Rupert Secondary School

Deadline for the completion of online registration is January 6, 2010 unless an earlier deadline is set by the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative.

- Registration is completed online by the designated contact for each sport in each region.
- Registration fees are to be submitted to the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative by the deadline.
- Completed Event and Team Lists (if applicable) must also be submitted to the Regional Representative by the deadline.
- Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
