## Wrestling

**Categories:**

**Open Female:** 12–18 years (11 weight classes)

**Participants:** 20 athletes plus 2 coaches/managers (22 max) per region. A maximum of 160 athletes and 16 coaches/managers are permitted for the sport.

**Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.

**Rules:** CAWA/BCWA/BC High School Regulations

**Eligibility:** Age as of December 31st prior to the Games.  
Must be a member of BC Wrestling Association. Forms available at venue prior to event.

**Coach Certification:** Coaches must be NCCP Part A Trained. Exemptions considered by BC Wrestling Association.

**Sanctioning:** BC Wrestling Association

**Entry Fee:** \$75.00 per Athlete; \$25.00 per Coach, Chaperone and Manager. Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.

**Tournament Draw:** Double Elimination. Round Robin where numbers dictate. Northern BC Winter Games competition will run on Friday and Saturday.

**Notes:** Weigh-in when zone bus arrives in the Host Community (Thursday night of the Games).

**Officials:** A maximum of 8 officials are permitted for the sport. Officials must be named and registration submitted to BC Games Society staff by the Games registration deadline.

**Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category, no medals will be awarded. This athlete/team may compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.

**Venue Requirements:** Venue with a flat one-room surface that can accommodate 2 mats (40 x 40 or 30 x 30 each).

- Completed Event and Team Lists (if applicable) must also be submitted to the Regional Representative by the deadline.
- Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
