2 Rounds Friday and 2 Rounds Saturday (Subject to participation)
Total Points (300 x 4 Rounds)

Notes: Juniors may shoot in Senior Categories.
Each team (region) should have a designated Coach or Manager.
Whites are requested, not mandatory.

Awards: GOLD, SILVER, BRONZE medals in each Category. When there are four or more competitors or teams, Bronze, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are three competitors or teams, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are two competitors or teams only a Gold medal will be awarded.
