



# Sport Technical Package

## 100 Mile House 2006 Northern B.C. Winter Games

### Badminton

- Categories:** Junior Under 16 Under 19  
~~Adult~~ ~~Open (19+)~~ cancelled
- Participants:** ~~12~~ 8 athletes (2 males & 2 females for each category) plus 2 coaches/managers (max ~~14~~ 10) per region. A maximum of ~~80~~ 96 athletes and 16 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern B.C. Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** Badminton BC
- Eligibility:** Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games.  
Memberships in Badminton BC required by regional playdowns.  
All participants play Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Technical 1. Exemptions must be approved by Badminton BC.
- Sanctioning:** Badminton BC
- Entry Fee:** \$60.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included)
- Tournament Draw:** Double Knockout
- Notes:** A list of partners is to accompany the registration.
- Officials:** A maximum of 8 officials are permitted for the sport
- Equipment:** Feather shuttles (78 speed) will be used for all competitions.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals in each age category for each division (singles, doubles, mixed doubles). When there are four or more competitors or teams, Bronze, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are three competitors or teams, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are two competitors or teams only a Gold medal will be awarded. Only Northern B.C. Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
- Venue Requirements:** Gymnasium with at least 3 courts of 20'x44' with five feet clearance around the courts on all sides. Nine metres (30 feet) clearance to ceiling without obstructions. Walls should be free of protrusions from below 14 feet.
- Venue:** Canim Lake Community Centre
