



# Sport Technical Package

## 100 Mile House 2006 Northern B.C. Winter Games

### Hockey

- Categories:** Senior Women's Division (13 and over)
- Participants:** One team of 19 players plus 3 team officials (Coaches/Managers/Trainers) (max. 22) per region. A maximum of 152 athletes and 24 team officials will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of teams indicated above. The members of other teams must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern B.C. Winter Games Society will backfill the unused team berths from the list of substitute teams, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** BCAHA Regulations.
- Eligibility:** Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games. Teams or individuals must be registered with BCAHA before November 1 of the year prior to the Games. No Hockey Canada carded players are permitted on teams. Membership in BCAHA required.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 Certified (BCAHA) and Speak Out clinic attendance required
- Sanctioning:** BCAHA
- Entry Fee:** \$60.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).
- Tournament Draw:** Round Robin
- Officials:** A maximum of 8 officials are permitted for the sport
- Notes:** Any participant under the age of 19 must be billeted and observe the midnight curfew.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded. When there are four or more competitors or teams, Bronze, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are three competitors or teams, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are two competitors or teams only a Gold medal will be awarded. Only Northern B.C. Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
- Venue Requirements:** ice surface – ideal size: 200' x 100'
- Venue:** Rolf Zeis Memorial Arena

- Roster for playdowns must be submitted to BCAHA District Director on or before November 1.
  - No carded players allowed to play in the Northern B.C. Winter Games
  - Female players and/or teams must be registered with the BCAHA before November 1 of the year prior to the Games
  - BCAHA District Directors to oversee playdowns for the Northern B.C. Winter Games

### Registration:

Teams wishing to playdown for the Northern B.C. Winter Games must contact their BCAHA District Director by November 1 of the current year. Team roster must be submitted to BCAHA District Director one week prior to the playdowns commencing. Playdowns for the Northern B.C. Winter Games must be completed by December 1 of the current year. Registration forms will be made available to the District playdown winner.
