- Categories:** Junior Boys 10-12 years old, born 1994-1996;
-40 kgs, -45 kgs, -48 kgs, -51 kgs, -55 kgs, -60 kgs, -66 kgs, +66 kgs
Junior Girls 10-12 years old, born 1994-1996;
-41 kgs, -44 kgs, -48 kgs, -52 kgs, -57 kgs, -63 kgs, +63 kgs
Juvenile Boys 13-15 years old, born 1991-1993;
-45 kgs, -48 kgs, -51 kgs, -55 kgs, -60 kgs, -66 kgs, -73 kgs, +73 kgs
Juvenile Girls 13-15 years old, born 1991-1993.
-41 kgs, -44 kgs, -48 kgs, -52 kgs, -57 kgs, -63 kgs, +63 kgs
- Team Matches:** Weight categories to be determined at the Games.
- Participants:** 15 athletes plus 1 coach and 1 manager (max 17) per region. Maximum 2 athletes per weight category. If region teams include both male and female athletes, the manager must be of the opposite gender of coach. A maximum of 85 athletes and 10 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern B.C. Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Eligibility:** Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games.
Minimum rank of gokyu (yellow belt), maximum of nikyu (blue belt).
Participants must be members in good standing with Judo BC.
- Rules:** International Judo Federation rules. Participants may compete in their registered weight category only. Dropping seoi nage and headlock techniques will be penalized.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 Certified
- Sanctioning:** Judo BC
- Entry Fee:** \$60.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).
- Officials:** A maximum of 10 officials are permitted for the sport.
- Tournament Draw:** Round robin. Individual match times are three (3) minutes
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals in each weight category. When there are four or more competitors or teams, Bronze, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are three competitors or teams, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are two competitors or teams only a Gold medal will be awarded. Only Northern B.C. Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
