## 100 Mile House 2006 Northern B.C. Winter Games

### Tae Kwon Do – (WTF)

- Categories:** Sparring and Patterns by Coloured Belt Divisions  
Children (10 - 15) Adult (16 and over)  
Beginner - White/Yellow/Green  
Intermediate – Blue/Red  
Advanced - Black Belt Stripe/Black Belt
- Participants** 12 athletes plus 1 coach and 1 manger (14 max) per region. A maximum of 84 athletes and 16 coaches/managers are permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern B.C. Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** Olympic Style Taekwondo Competition Rules
- Eligibility:** Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games.  
Athletes must be Students of Taekwondo with an understanding of the rules.  
A waiver, provided by BC Taekwondo Association, must be completed and signed upon registration or before competition.
- Coaching Level:** NCCP Level 1 Technical recommended.
- Sanctioning:** BC Taekwondo Association
- Entry Fee:** \$60.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).
- Tournament Draw:** As determined by entry and Taekwondo standard tournament package.
- Officials:** A maximum of 4 officials are permitted for the sport
- Equipment:** Personal safety equipment (shin, groin, arm guards, head and chest protectors) must be provided by the competitor.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in each age and belt category. When there are four or more competitors or teams, Bronze, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are three competitors or teams, Silver and Gold medals will be awarded. When there are two competitors or teams only a Gold medal will be awarded. Only Northern B.C. Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
- Venue requirements:** Gymnasium with minimum dimension of 20m x 30m, not including spectator seating. An additional 10m x 30m is required if bleacher seating is not available.
- Venue:** Bethel Church Gymnasium
