Dawson Creek 2008 Northern BC Winter Games

February 7-10, 2008

Bowling

- Categories:** **Youth Division:** Combined Junior (11-13) and Senior (14-18)
 Seniors Division: 55 and over
 Special Olympics: Co-ed (12 and over)
- Participants** **Youth Division:** 2 males (one from each age category) and 2 females (one from each age category) plus 1 Coach / Manager (5 max.) per region. A maximum of 32 athlete and 16 coaches/ managers will be permitted for the sport in the Youth Division.
- Seniors Division:** 2 males and 2 females plus 1 coach/manager per region. A maximum of 32 athletes and 8 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport in the Seniors Division.
- Special Olympics:** 5 players plus 1 Coach per region. A maximum of 40 athletes and 8 coaches will be permitted for the sport in the Special Olympics Division. Note that chaperones will be permitted to be added, as required.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** Canadian and BC Five Pin Bowling Association rules and regulations.
- Eligibility:** Age as of Dec. 31st year prior to the Games.
 Eligibility is based on most pins over average.
 Only non-playing coaches will be permitted. Bowlers will not be part of a team event.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 certification.
- Sanctioning:** Bowl BC
- Entry Fee:** The Northern BC Winter Games Society fee is \$65.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included). Athletes in Bowling will pay an additional \$30 each, to cover line fees. Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
- Tournament Draw:** Single round robin. 8 game – pins over average
- Officials:** A maximum of 2 judges of play are permitted for the sport. Officials must be named and registration submitted to BC Games Society staff by December 1, 2007.

Awards:

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
