**Ages for all categories:** As defined by GBC

- Participants:** 25 females and 5 males (spots allocated to one gender may not be filled with athletes from the other gender) plus 5 coaches/chaperones (Max 35) per region. A maximum of 180 athletes and 30 coaches/managers are permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern B.C. Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:**  
Women: Canadian Provincial Program, 2007-2008 Edition  
GYMSTART, 2007-2008 Edition  
Men: Gymnastics Canada Gymnastique Levels Program rules, 2007-2008 Edition
- Eligibility:** Age as defined by Gymnastics BC, except where age categories are combined. Gymnasts must be registered as Competitive Gymnasts with GBC and must compete in their GBC registered category. Coaches and judges must be GBC registered members.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 2 Certification required
- Sanctioning:** Gymnastics BC
- Entry Fee:** \$65.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included). Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
- Lunch Money:** Lunches will not be provided. It is the responsibility of the Athletes to bring money for their lunches.
- Competition Draw:** 1<sup>st</sup> day: Women 2 events / Men 3 events  
2<sup>nd</sup> day: Women 2 events / Men 3 events  
The choice of events for each day will depend on the size of the facility. The Sport Chair will draw the starting order. GBC may provide help if necessary.
- Officials:** A maximum of 10 judges / officials are permitted for the sport. Officials must be named and registration submitted to BC Games Society staff by December 1, 2007.



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**Judging:** All judges must be registered with Gymnastics BC. Zones 7 and 8 Judging Chairs will submit the names and of the judges from their Zone to the GNGTC. They will also do and confirm the assignments with all judges at least 2 weeks prior to the Games. The optimum number of judging per panel is 4, with a minimum of 2. Trainee judges are permitted but not to be considered in the minimum number allowed. Judge's panel will consist of:

Competitive Head Judge	Women's Prov 4 or higher	Men's Regional
Event Chief Judge (A1)	Prov 3 or higher	Regional
First Judge (B Panel)	Prov 2 or higher	Regional
Remaining Judges (B Panel)	Prov 1 or higher	Regional

#### **Gymnastics Northern Games Technical Committee:**

A technical Committee will be established. Members will be:

- Zone 7 Representative
- Zone 8 Representative
- LOC Representative
- GBC Representative.

The GNGTC will be in charge of:

- Approving the Technical Package
- Approving all organizational items
- Provide Technical Support for the LOC
- Coordinate between Zones, GBC and LOC
- The GBC Zone Reps will be in charge of filling out the registration forms for all clubs in their Region as defined by the Northern BC Winter Games Society (copy must be sent to GBC and LOC – for scheduling).
- Confirm Judges Assignments to Northern BC Games Society

**Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.

WAG: No Team Awards

For each age group, Medals for All around and each event will be awarded.

MAG: No Team Awards

A certificate stating their results will be given to each athlete.

One medal will be awarded to each athlete, Gold, Silver or Bronze, according to their AA result.



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**Venue Requirements:** A gymnasium 80'x100' would allow equipment for both men and women competitions to be set up simultaneously. A smaller facility would require set-up and take down between competition days. Ceiling height of at least 22' is required. 33m length required for the vault. Two or three floor plates is ideal, separated by a distance of 13'1" x 18'1". If floor plates are not available, freestanding equipment must be used. A meeting room for 12-15 adults for the judges is required.

Registration fees are to be submitted to your Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative by the deadline. A complete Team List (for team events) must also be submitted to the Regional Representative by the deadline.

Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted
