<b>Participants</b>	11 athletes in any combination of categories plus 1 Coach/Manager (12 max) per region. A maximum of 88 athletes and 8 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport.
<b>Backfilling:</b>	Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
<b>Rules:</b>	B.C. Archery Association
<b>Eligibility:</b>	Age at December 31 prior to the Games. Athletes must be members of the B.C. Archery Association.
<b>Sanctioning:</b>	B.C. Archery Association
<b>Coach Certification:</b>	NCCP Level 1 certification is required.
<b>Entry Fee:</b>	\$65.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).
<b>Tournament Draw:</b>	4 Rounds FITA I (30 arrows at 18 metres) 2 Rounds Friday and 2 Rounds Saturday (Subject to participation) Total Points (300 x 4 Rounds)
<b>Notes:</b>	Juniors may shoot in Senior Categories. Each team (region) should have a designated Coach or Manager. Whites are requested, not mandatory.
<b>Officials:</b>	A maximum of 4 officials are permitted for the sport
<b>Awards:</b>	Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
<b>Venue Requirements:</b>	absolute minimum is 70'x70'. The light source must be artificial overhead lighting.
<b>Venue:</b>	Totem Archery – Taylor Community Hall
