Fort St. John 2007 Northern BC Winter Games

Ringette

- Categories:** U13 (11-12)
- Participants:** One team of 17 players plus 4 Coaches/ Managers per region. A maximum of 102 (6 teams) and 18 Coaches/ Managers will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of teams indicated above. Other teams must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitute teams, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** BC Ringette Rules
- Eligibility:** Age as of Dec. 31st prior to the Games.
Athletes must be registered with the BC Ringette Association. All-star teams will be formed in each region.
- Coach Certification:** Coaches must be NCCP Level 1 Certified. Managers will be certified through Ringette Canada's Manager Certification Program. Bench staff must reflect the gender balance of the team.
- Sanctioning:** BC Ringette Association
- Entry Fee:** \$65.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).
- Tournament Draw:** Tournament draw to be determined by the BC Ringette Association. Round Robin will be used if 4 or more teams, Double Round Robin, if 3 teams.
- Officials:** A maximum of 6 officials are permitted for the sport
- Venue Requirements:** arena 200'x100' is preferred
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
