- Categories:** ~~Regional 1 and Regional 2 skaters Midget to Senior + all Masters. - CANCELLED~~
- ~~Midget (10 - 11) — Juvenile (12 - 13) — Junior (14 - 15)
Intermediate (16 - 17) — Senior (18 and over) — Masters (30 and over)~~
- Participants:** ~~12-0~~ athletes plus ~~02~~ Coaches/ Managers per region. A maximum of ~~096~~ athletes plus ~~046~~ Coaches/ Managers will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other teams must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitute teams, based on policy and ability to host.
- Eligibility:** Age as of June 30th prior to the Games. All competitors must be competitive members of the BCSSA and SSC. Any changes in eligibility caused by a shortage of ice time will be provided to registered participants well in advance of the event.
- Rules:** SSC and B.C. Speed Skating Association rules.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 Certified
- Sanctioning:** BCSSA - Sanction is required. No records will be kept.
- Entry Fee:** \$65.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included).
- Tournament Draw:** Mass Start. Subject to available ice time. Format will be Age Class. Team pursuits will be held if time permits. Seeding will be done on times submitted. Clubs entering skaters will be contacted for seed times by the Sport Chair in advance of the event.
- Notes:** All skaters must dress according to the venue and the weather. Skaters must wear bib numbers provided for the competition. Coaches meeting will be held before the first race. Notification as to time and location to be contained in coaches' package.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
