**Categories:**                   **Open MALE (12-18 years)** (17 weight classes)

**Participants:**                   20 athletes plus 2 coaches/managers (22 max) per region. A maximum of 160 athletes and 16 coaches/managers are permitted for the sport.

**Backfilling:**                   Each region may only register the number of athletes indicated above. Other athletes must be registered as Substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.

**Coaching Level:**               Coaches must be NCCP Part A Trained, exemptions considered by BC Wrestling Association

**Rules:**                           CAWA/ BCWA/BC High School Regulations

**Eligibility:**                    Age as of December 31st prior to the Games.  
Must be a member of BC Wrestling Association. Forms available at venue prior to event.

**Sanctioning:**                 BC Wrestling Association

**Registration Fee:**            \$70.00 per Participant (Coaches and Managers included). Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.

**Tournament Draw:**           Double Elimination. Round Robin where numbers dictate. Northern BC Winter Games competition will run in Friday. A clinic and the Zone competition will take place on Saturday.

**Notes:**                         Weigh-in on arrival in the Host Community.

**Officials:**                    A maximum of 8 officials are permitted for the sport. Officials must be named and registration submitted to BC Games Society staff by December 1, 2008.

**Awards:** Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category, no medals will be awarded; this athlete/team however, will be presented with a participation certificate. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.

**Venue Requirements:** A venue with a flat one-room surface that can accommodate 2 mats (40x40 or 30x30 each).
