Prince Rupert 2010 Northern BC Winter Games

February 4 - 7, 2010

Karate

- Categories:** Male & Female events in the following:
8-9 years (Host Community athletes only) 10-11 years 12-13 years
14-15 years 16-17 years 18 years and over
** Weight divisions for all categories will be determined based on entries.*
- Participants:** 20 athletes plus 2 coaches/managers (max 22) per region. A maximum of 160 athletes and 16 coaches/managers will be permitted for the sport.
- Backfilling:** Each region may only register the number of participants indicated above. Other participants must be registered as substitutes. Once registration is complete, the Northern BC Winter Games Society will backfill the unused spots from the list of substitutes, based on policy and ability to host.
- Rules:** As per Karate BC policy.
- Eligibility:** Age as of December 31st prior to the Games.
Athletes must be members of Karate BC 30 days prior to the Games in order to participate.
- Coach Certification:** NCCP Level 1 Certification required.
- Sanctioning:** Karate BC
- Entry Fee:** \$75.00 per Athlete; \$25 per Coach/Manager/Trainer. Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
- Tournament Draw:** Kata: elimination/performance. Repechage system.
Kumite: Repechage system. Round Robin with three or fewer competitors.
- Notes:** All participants must show Karate BC membership at time of participation in the Regional Playdowns. Karate BC or N.K.A. waiver form must be completed by all participants.
- Officials:** A maximum of 12 officials will be permitted for the sport. Officials must be named and registration submitted to BC Games Society staff by the Games registration deadline. An Officials Clinic will be held in conjunction with the competition.
- Awards:** Gold, Silver and two (2) Bronze medals will be awarded in all categories or events, as specified in Sport Technical Package, where a competition exists. If there is only one person or team in an event or category, no medals will be awarded. This athlete/team may also compete in an alternate category/event, if the sport's rules permit. Only Northern BC Winter Games Society medals are permitted to be awarded.
- Venue Requirements:** High School or Middle School gymnasium, large enough to hold two competition areas of 12 x 12 each with safety space between.
- Venue:** Roosevelt Community School

Registration:

Online registration information is available from the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative.

Deadline for the completion of online registration is January 6, 2010 unless an earlier deadline is set by the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative.

- Registration is completed online by the designated contact for each sport in each region.
- Registration fees are to be submitted to the Northern BC Winter Games Society Regional Representative by the deadline.
- Completed Event and Team Lists (if applicable) must also be submitted to the Regional Representative by the deadline.
- Fees for all participants from the region must be submitted with one cheque payable to the Northern BC Winter Games Society by the registration deadline. Cash or individual payments for athletes will not be accepted.
